INGREDIENTS

Box of Twinkies

Small Bag of Candy-Coated Chocolate Candies (M&Ms)

Sliced Almonds

Chocolate Frosting Gel

INSTRUCTIONS

Begin by unwrapping each Twinkie depending on how many furry friends you plan on having in your guinea pig army.

Next, open up your sliced almonds and place one on the left side and one on the right side of the head of your Twinkie, these will be your guinea pig's ears.

Then add two more on the lower left and right sides of the body, these will be your guinea pig's legs.

Then, using your chocolate gel as a form of glue, place two large dots on the face of the guinea pig and stick a blue M&M over each dot. These will be your guinea pig's hypnotized eyes.

Finally, use the chocolate gel to draw a distractingly cute nose and mouth for your guinea pig.

Repeat each of the steps above for every member of your guinea pig army.

INSTRUCTIONS

With the help of your parents place the sliced fruit in a blender.

Add water as needed.

Add sugar or natural honey for extra sweetness.

Blend until liquefied and pour into cups.

Top with fruit slices, and use them to keep the popsicle sticks upright.

Freeze overnight.















SSSNAKES AND SSSAUCE

Invite your good (and bad) friends for a pizza party, these bread sticks and marinara are so tasty! When you finish your snack, post a picture with the hashtag #GOODERTOGETHER

INGREDIENTS

Plain Bread Stick Dough Sharp Cheddar Cheese

Pizza Sauce

Olives (Optional)

Pepperoni

Mozzarella Sticks

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 375° and layout rectangular piece of dough, and cut into 12 even slices.

Next, gently hold down one end of the dough while twisting the other end. Repeat for each piece. Bake for 7-8 minutes.

Take dough out and add cheddar cheese and pepperoni to each. Place pepperoni near flat side of the snake.

Put pan back in oven and bake for an additional 4-6 minutes.

Cut olives into small cubes for eyes and mozzarella sticks for flowers. Cut pepperoni into long rectangles for tongue. Place mozzarella into flower shapes on top of the pepperoni, and add olives for eyes on flat part of the breadstick.

Lastly, heat up marinara sauce in a microwave safe bowl for 30 seconds to 1 minute.







MR. SNAKE'S BIRTHDAY CAKE

Let's take a break to celebrate Mr. Snake and bake him his favorite cake! Start with the below recipe for extra chocolaty frosting and then go to the next page to make a yummy yellow sheet cake. These recipes are provided in partnership with AMERICA'S TEST KITCHEN KIDS.

CHOCOLATE FROSTING INGREDIENTS

1% Cups (10 Ounces) Chocolate Chips $\,$ 1 Cup (4 Ounces) Confectioners'

(Bittersweet, Semisweet, or Milk (Powdered) Sugar

Chocolate) 3/4 Cup (21/4 Ounces) Dutch-Processed

20 Tablespoons Unsalted Butter, Cut Cocoa Powder

Into 20 Pieces and Softened 3/4 Teaspoon Vanilla Extract

INSTRUCTIONS

Place chocolate chips in medium microwave-safe bowl. Heat in microwave at 50 percent power for 1 minute. Use rubber spatula to stir chocolate. Return to microwave and heat at 50 percent power until melted and smooth, about 1 minute longer.

Let cool slightly, about 5 minutes.

Add softened butter, sugar, cocoa powder, and salt to food processor, and lock lid into place. Turn on processor and process until smooth, about 30 seconds. Stop processor.

Remove lid and use rubber spatula to scrape down sides. Add cooled chocolate and vanilla and lock lid back into place. Turn on processor and process until smooth, 10-15 seconds. Stop processor.

Remove lid and carefully remove processor blade (ask an adult for help).

YELLOW SHEET CAKE INGREDIENTS

Vegetable Oil Spray

2¼ Cups (9 Ounces) Cake Flour

1¼ Teaspoons Baking Powder

1/4 Teaspoon Baking Soda

34 Teaspoon Salt

4 Large Eggs

134 Cups (1214 Ounces) Sugar

10 Tablespoons Unsalted Butter, Melted and Cooled

5 Tablespoons Vegetable Oil

34 Cup (6 Ounces) Buttermilk

2 Teaspoons Vanilla Extract

3 Cups Chocolate Frosting



INSTRUCTIONS

Adjust oven rack to middle position and heat oven to 350°. Spray inside bottom and sides of 13-by-9-inch metal baking pan with vegetable oil spray. Line bottom of baking pan with 13-by-9-inch piece of parchment paper.

In medium bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt.

Add eggs to bowl of stand mixer (or large bowl if using handheld mixer). Lock bowl into place and attach whisk attachment to stand mixer, if using. Start mixer on medium speed. Whip eggs until foamy, 1-2 minutes. Stop mixer.

Add sugar to eggs and start mixer on medium-high speed. Whip mixture until pale yellow and fluffy, about 3 minutes.

Reduce speed to medium. With mixer running, very slowly pour in melted butter and oil and mix until fully combined, about 2 minutes. Stop mixer.

Carefully add half of flour mixture. Start mixer on low speed and mix until just combined, about 30 seconds. With mixer running, add buttermilk and vanilla and mix until combined, about 30 seconds. Stop mixer.

Add remaining flour mixture. Start mixer on low speed and mix until just combined and no dry flour is visible, about 30 seconds. Stop mixer. Remove bowl from stand mixer, if using.

Use rubber spatula to scrape down sides of bowl and stir in any remaining dry flour.
Use rubber spatula to scrape batter into parchment-lined baking pan and smooth top (make sure to spread batter into corners to create even layer).

Place baking pan in oven. Bake until cake is golden brown and toothpick inserted in center comes out with few crumbs attached, 27-30 minutes.

Use oven mitts to remove baking pan from oven (ask an adult for help). Place baking pan on cooling rack and let cake cool completely in pan, about 2 hours.

Remove cake from baking pan and discard parchment. Use icing spatula to spread frosting evenly over top and sides of cooled cake. Cut cake into pieces and serve.













SHARK-BITE SNACK CUPS

Make your own watch-party snack holders. Movies and snacks are better together, just like the Bad Guys! Stuff it with all your favorite dry snacks.

YOU WILL NEED

Blue Plastic Cup (As Many as You Need)

White Paper

Gray Paper or Card Stock

Scissors

Marker

Googly Eyes (optional)

Tape and Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

Start by cutting the shark teeth from a strip of white paper. Make shark fin from gray paper or card stock as shown in the example photo above.

Cut two small circles for the eyes from white paper and draw a black circle in the middle of the white circle with a marker, or you may use googly eyes if you have them.

Lay the cup on the side and make a slit, with the help of an adult, in the size of the fin, insert the fin and tape it down on the inside.

Tape the strips of teeth on the opening of the cup. Glue the eyes on the side of the cup. Add the gills with a marker on the side, 5-6 lines behind the eyes.











TRASH ART SCULPTURE

Even trash can be recycled into something beautiful! Invite your friends and family to each create sculptures out of "building materials" found around your house. When you're finished, use a flashlight to see what you can find in the shadows!

YOU WILL NEED

Low Heat Glue Gun Paint (Optional)

Recyclables From Around Scissors (Optional)

Your House Flashlight (Optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

Collect trash and recyclables from around the house, they will serve as the materials you'll use to build your sculpture.

Use the pieces to experiment with different arrangements until you find one that you like.

Use the glue gun when necessary to glue pieces of your sculpture together, try and make the sculpture as sturdy as possible.

As an optional step, consider painting some or all of the pieces once they are arranged.

When the sculptures are finished, arrange them near each other and experiment with the flashlight to see what objects, people or animals you can find in the shadows!













LOVE METEORITE NIGHT LIGHT

Shed some love rays with your own meteorite light! It's your reminder of how there's good even in the darkest places.

YOU WILL NEED

Cardboard White Glue Blue Tissue Paper Pencil

Scissors White Paint String Lights Baking Soda

INSTRUCTIONS

Trace two heart meteor shapes from the next page onto cardboard and cut them out. Only one of the hearts needs to have holes cut, leave the other whole.

On the heart piece with holes, glue strips of the tissue paper on one side so that it covers the heart like in the second image below, wait 10-15 minutes for it to dry.

Put a layer glue along the cut seams on the other side of the heart, then mix equal parts baking soda and white paint. Cover it with your paint mixture being careful not to get it on the blue parts, then wait 10-15 minutes for it to dry.

Time to assemble your meteor! Start by folding the rectangular cardboard strip in half and then put white glue along one side like in the third image below, then affix it to one of the heart cutouts. Hold it in place while it dries for 5 minutes.

Repeat the previous step on the other side of the rectangular piece and affix the other cardboard heart to the light, press together firmly and then let it dry for an additional 5 minutes. Place your string lights inside and enjoy!
















SAVE THE KITTEN MAZE

YOU WILL NEED

Bundle of Gray Yarn Scissors Safety Pin

INSTRUCTIONS

Start by cutting the yarn into 15 long identical pieces depending on how long you want your tail to be (you can always trim later).

String the group of yarn strands through the center of a safety pin, making sure it is evenly divided on both sides.

Fold the yarn over the side of the safety pin and braid until it is the length you want your tail to be.

Tie a knot at the bottom of the braid to hold the yarn together.

INSTRUCTIONS

Begin by picking a member of your crew to be the first "good guy." This person will be "it."

The first "good guy" then uses the tail from the craft from page 11 and places one end in their waistband or a pocket where all can see (make sure not to use the safety pin attachment for this game).

Set an initial starting point for the game. Everyone stands at this starting point except for the "good guy" who gets a 15-second head start.

After 15 seconds everyone else is able to join in the chase to pull the tail from the "good guy."

Whoever captures the tail is then the next "good guy." Play for ten rounds altogether to find out who remains wearing the tail among your crew.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using a bowl or someone's head, cut and tape a length of construction paper to a size that can sit comfortably on someone's head.

With an adult, cut six more strips of construction paper in even lengths.

Tape each end of a strip to the inside of the previously made ring, rounding the strip over the top of the helmet. Repeat for every strip.

Place tape on the inside of the paper cups leaving a portion of it hanging out. Place the cups wherever you wish on the helmet.

Twist a couple of pipe cleaners around your finger or a spoon to make a coil.


Cut a hole in the bottom of the cups and poke the pipe cleaners through them.

YOU WILL NEED

2 Buckets
A Hose and Water Supply
A Jar of Cherries
Pack of Balloons, Preferably Red

INSTRUCTIONS

Fill all your balloons with water and choose one balloon to "hide" the cherry in. When you're done filling the balloons, collect them all together into one big pile.

Divide into teams or play as individuals and assign each team or individual a bucket. Make sure the pile of water balloons is within running distance of the buckets. Consider creating an obstacle course if you want the game to be more fun!

On the count of three, each team member or individual should retrieve a water balloon from the pile and then pop it into their bucket, every time you pop a balloon look into the bucket to see if it was the one hiding the "Maraschino Ruby."

The first team or individual to find the balloon with the cherry wins the game and captures the Maraschino Ruby!
